To approve the minutes of the regular meeting on April 4, 2011. All aye.

To approve the bid from Inside Out in the amount of \$1,520.00 to decorate the downtown planters for spring/summer season to be paid from Tourism. All aye.

Alderman Eimen reported that Royce Ballard will be replacing two trees in the planters and a few bushes in the empty lot on N Central next to Merkle Services.

Mayor Theesfeld received a proposal from Larry Eyre who has been working on the project at the old City dump. The proposal was for the five planters in the amount of \$350-800.00 depending on what type of plants used. They have helpers lined up from Nexus.

To approve up to \$750.00 from the Tourism for the project proposed by Larry Eyre for the property at the corner of E Second St and Rt 45. All aye.

Alderman Strohschein questioned sidewalk replacement, she will make a list and report back to council. Strohschein also asked if the city was selling bricks, she was informed that there were bricks at the sewer plant and we would sell them for .15 each.

Tom Strohschein questioned the tile work which was done on Peoria Street and asked if the culvert would be replaced. Mayor Theesfeld reported that Iroquois Paving would be grading that alley way off to eliminate the culvert. He also questioned the smashed culvert on the other end, and Theesfeld said that Iroquois Paving would also be fixing that. Tom questioned if there would be access to the alley off of 2nd street to lead to Front Street, previously that entrance had been eliminated, Theesfeld noted that there would be access to the alley and that all driveways would be replaced with asphalt.

Roscoe Mason, Mayor Theesfeld and Alderman McGehee all thanked Eimen, St Peter and Johnson for their years of service to the City of Gilman and wished the newly elected alderman good luck with their new positions.
